## Speaker: Rev. Alex Awad

Born and raised in Jerusalem, Alex Awad has been a lifelong follower of Jesus, practicing his Christian faith in the places Jesus walked. He was instrumental in starting Bethlehem Bible College, the first and only evangelical college in the city of Jesus' birth. He has taught classes on Mission, Peacemaking, and the Bible in the Holy Land.



He will bring his years of knowledge and experience to Albuquerque, offering a unique Palestinian evangelical perspective on the Holy Land, answering questions many people in the U.S. have, such as:

- What prevents peace between Israel and Palestine?
- What does the Bible say to the situation in the Holy Land today?
- Who are the Palestinian Christians?
- What are the challenges and opportunities of interfaith dialogue?

He has spent years sharing about these hotly contested topics with Christian love and kindness. Don't miss this chance to hear Rev. Awad speak about this pivotal part of the world.

*For 26 years, Rev. Awad and his wife Brenda served together as missionaries with the General Board of Global Ministries of the United Methodist Church in Israel/Palestine. He was the pastor of an international church in East Jerusalem and taught courses at Bethlehem Bible College, where he served as faculty member, Dean of Students, and board member. Rev. Awad has written two books on the Palestinian Christian experience, **Through the Eyes of the Victims** and **Palestinian Memories**. He continues to write articles that call for justice for all people in the Holy Land.*
